Aquaculture Horizons 2026

International conference & expo on aquaculture & seafood (Aquaculture Horizons 2026) will be held in Singapore, The Aquaculture Horizons 2026 promises to be an immersive exploration of the latest trends, breakthroughs, and sustainable practices shaping the future of aquaculture.

Seaweed is rapidly emerging as a transformative force in the blue economy—offering solutions for food security, environmental resilience, and economic diversification. Technical discussions will examine genetics and breeding, farm design, mechanization, and integrated multi-trophic aquaculture (IMTA) models. Attention will also be given to food safety, certification, and investment readiness for both small-scale and commercial producers. This theme will also explore policy and ecosystem governance challenges, including permitting, spatial planning, and ecosystem impacts. As regulatory frameworks begin to catch up with industry growth, there is a critical opportunity to align science, industry, and policy to support sustainable seaweed expansion.

Experts will share insights on seaweed's role in regenerative ocean farming, blue carbon initiatives, and emerging blue finance mechanisms. Case studies from successful farms, cooperatives, and start-ups will showcase the real-world potential of seaweed to create jobs, diversify coastal economies, and restore marine ecosystems. By bringing together scientists, entrepreneurs, investors, policy-makers, Indigenous leaders, and coastal communities, the seaweed theme aims to spark cross-sector collaboration and advance a shared vision for this fast-growing sector.


































ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DETAILS
