The theme will also highlight the role of investment, private-public collaboration, and education in building resilient and future-ready shrimp farming operations. Singapore's strategic position in the Asia-Pacific region makes it an ideal location to convene shrimp industry stakeholders, researchers, technology providers, and policymakers. The sessions will foster knowledge exchange, partnerships, and actionable solutions to advance a smarter, healthier, and more sustainable shrimp industry worldwide.


































ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DETAILS
