Aquaculture Horizons 2026

International conference & expo on aquaculture & seafood (Aquaculture Horizons 2026) will be held in Singapore. The Aquaculture Horizons 2026 promises to be an immersive exploration of the latest trends, breakthroughs, and sustainable practices shaping the future of aquaculture.

Special attention will be given to species-specific strategies—including finfish, shrimp, bivalves, and emerging candidates such as sea cucumbers and algae—and their role in regional development, especially in Asia, which leads global production. Case studies will highlight successful public-private partnerships, policy frameworks, and R&D collaborations that are unlocking new potential across the value chain.

The conference will serve as a platform for producers, researchers, policymakers, technology providers, and investors to exchange knowledge, share innovations, and foster collaborations that push the boundaries of what aquaculture can achieve. Whether addressing sustainable intensification, ecosystem integration, or equitable livelihoods, this theme underscores aquaculture's essential contribution to resilient and future-ready food systems. As Singapore positions itself as a hub for blue economy innovation, this theme will also explore regional leadership in shaping a responsible and technologically advanced aquaculture industry—one that nourishes people, protects the planet, and supports thriving coastal and rural communities.
