By bringing together producers, processors, exporters, buyers, certification bodies, and technology innovators, the seafood track will foster cross-sector dialogue and collaboration. With Singapore serving as a key global trade and logistics hub, this theme will also explore the city-state's leadership in advancing digital seafood commerce, regional trade integration, and food safety innovation—positioning it as an ideal meeting ground for shaping the future of seafood.


































ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DETAILS
